I MISSION OF THE KAY CLINT FUND FOR EMERGING NEEDS.

The mission of the Kay Clint Fund for Emerging Needs is to stimulate new, creative or experimental programs and services to meet unmet or emerging social needs within the geographic area of the United Way of Washington County-East.

II. STATEMENT OF GUIDELINES AND PRIORITIES FOR FUNDING.

Emerging need grants are not intended to be used as an additional source of regular annual funding for an agency or organization. The grants are for new, creative or experimental programs that address pressing needs in the United Way of Washington County-East's service area that are not being met by other agencies' programs.

The following general guide will be used to evaluate proposals submitted for a Kay Clint Fund for Emerging Needs grant:

- A. The program is new, creative and/or innovative and not included in the agency's regular program budget.
- B. The program will meet a new or unmet need in the geographic area of the United Way of Washington County-East (Stillwater Area School District, ISD #834).
- C. If funded, the program has a high potential for success.
- D. The program has a reasonable ability to become self-sufficient after the initial funding.
- E. The proposal articulates specific and measurable objectives and outcomes.
